- 2. From a novel you have chosen to study, select a passage where the subject is the death of a character or characters. Outline how you would establish the mood of the scene and how you would stage it to convey the importance of the event to an audience.
- **3.** From a novel you have chosen to study, select a passage which conveys a sense of intrigue. Outline how, by staging and action, you might present this scene and its significance to an audience.
